INDIVIDUAL SUPPLY LIST

- Water Bottle (To be left at school)
- Small Tote/Bag
- 4 Composition Notebooks (not spiral, please)
- 4 Folders with inside pockets
- Scissors (large scissors, please!)

OPTIONAL INDIVIDUAL SUPPLIES

- Locker Shelf
 - *Students this year found it very helpful to have a locker shelf so their small tote/bag and supplies could be kept separate and easy to get to
- Locker Decorations
 - *Some students like to decorate the inside of their lockers.
 - That is completely fine as long as they can still get to their school work easily

COMMUNITY SUPPLY LIST

- ❖ 2 packs of #2 Ticonderoga pencils
- ❖ 2 packs of pink erasers
- ❖ 1 pack of bold markers (for poster projects)
- ❖ 5-6 packs of glue sticks (yes, we go through a LOT of glue with our project based learning!) :)
- ❖ 1 bottle of wet glue
- ❖ 2 packs of disinfectant wipes
- ❖ 1 box of tissues
- ❖ 2 packs of dry erase markers
- ❖ 4 black sharpies (2 regular fine tip, and 2 extra fine tip)
