## **INDIVIDUAL SUPPLY LIST**

- Water Bottle (*That will stay at school*)
- Small Tote/Bag
  - \*Large backpacks do **not** fit in the half lockers well with student supplies
- 4 Composition Notebooks (not spiral, please)
  - \*Math, Language Arts, Science, Spanish
- 5 Folders with inside pockets
  - \*Math, Language Arts, Science, Spanish, Genius Hour/Unfinished Business
- Scissors (large scissors are fine, student preference)

## **OPTIONAL INDIVIDUAL SUPPLIES**

- Locker Shelf
  - \*Students this year found it very helpful to have a locker shelf so their small tote/bag and supplies could be kept separate and easy to get to
- Locker Decorations
  - \*Some students like to decorate the inside of their lockers.  
That is completely fine as long as they can still get to their work easily

## **COMMUNITY SUPPLY LIST**

- ❖ 2 packs of #2 pencils
- ❖ 2 packs of pink erasers
- ❖ 1 pack of colored pencils
- ❖ 1 pack of bold markers (for poster projects and art)
- ❖ 1 highlighter
- ❖ 5-6 packs of glue sticks (yes, we go through a LOT of glue with our project based learning!) :)
- ❖ 2 packs of disinfectant wipes or baby wipes
- ❖ 1 box of tissues
